Holding Method: On-the-job training by instructor (Simulated collision, braking, cornering, etc.), Simple

Inspection Method for Motorcycles, Inspection of student's bikes by Hayasaka Cycle

*Notes: Please come with your own bike for hands-on training. Wear clothing suitable for motorcycle riding. Check the expiration date of your liability insurance._
