

# Notice on AY 2022 Fall Chest X-rays (November)

Fall chest X-rays will be conducted for students entering the university in October 2022.

**All fall chest X-rays are by reservation only.** Please make a reservation online in advance.



**Dates:** November 15 (Tue.), 11:00–13:40 (male and female exchange system. please be on time.)  
**11:00-11:30, 12:30-13:20 (male) 11:30-12:30, 13:20-13:40(female)**

**Location:** Tohoku University Student Health Care Center (Kawauchi Kita Campus) A09

Note: There are no parking spaces, so please use public transportation.



**Eligibility:** Students entering the university in October 2022 (including non-degree students who entered in/after May 2022 and will be enrolled for 1 month or longer)

Note: Short-term Visiting Trainees are not included with non-degree students.

Note: Students who underwent the Regular Medical Checkups in May 2022 are not included, even if they are eligible as described above (e.g. transfer students).

**Appointment:** Please make a reservation online in advance. Read the instructions below.

Reservations can be made starting November 7. Please make your reservation by November 13.

**Examination Items:** Chest X-ray etc.

-When undergoing the X-ray, you may need to adjust your clothes and hair.

Please read the attached "Instructions for Undergoing the Chest X-ray."

**Please bring:**

-Student ID card, or document (such as enrollment notice) that shows your name and student ID number

-Wear or bring **a thin plain t-shirt** to wear during the X-ray.

**If you are not prepared, you will be unable to take the X-ray.**

**Reason for the chest X-ray**

Chest X-rays are required by Japanese law (School Hygiene and Safety Act) to prevent diseases such as tuberculosis.

**Results and Medical Examination Certificate**

-If you require additional tests, you will be contacted by phone by December 2 (Fri.).

-Medical Examination Certificates will be issued by the Student Health Care Center on/after December 5 (Mon.).

Please bring your Student ID card. Please check our office hours on the Student Health Care Center website.

**Working Students**

-If you underwent a medical exam that included a chest X-ray at your place of employment (or are scheduled to do so) during this academic year, you may submit a photocopy of your results to the Student Health Care Center in place of undergoing the fall chest X-ray.

However, in this case the center will be unable to issue a Medical Examination Certificate.

**Requests:**

-Please wear a mask to the exam.

-If you feel unwell, or any of the following applies, do NOT undergo the exam.

-You have COVID-19 symptoms, or such symptoms subsided less than 24 hours before the exam.

-You have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and have not fully recovered.

-You have been in close contact with a COVID-19 patient, and will still be in the monitoring period on the date of the exam.

-You have entered Japan from abroad, and will still be in the post-arrival quarantine period on the date of the exam.

-The above information may change in the event of an emergency (natural disaster etc.) or due to the COVID-19 infection rate.
