Test Subjects	Description
English	At the time of application, submit an original TOEFL® Test or TOEIC® Score sheet no older than two years before the entrance exam. TOEFL iBT Home Edition scores are also accepted.
Oral test	Within 15-minute presentation on master's thesis (completed or in progress; may use PC), followed by questions about the presentation contents.
<u>Specialized Subjects</u>	<p><u>Choice of 3 questions from 4 questions on the test.</u></p> <p><u>Prospected adviser selects 1-4 fields from the list below, considering applicant's background, filed of specialization and research plan. In total 4 questions from the selected fields will be on the test.</u></p> <p><u>1. Mathematics (calculus, linear algebra, probability and statistics) 2.
