(Master's Program: Special Selection Program for Foreign Students)

Test Subjects	Description
English	At the time of application, submit TOEFL® or TOEIC® score sheet no older than two years before the entrance exam. TOEFL iBT Home Edition scores are not accepted.
<u>Basic subjects</u>	Choice of 2 questions from the following 6 areas: electromagnetics, electrical circuits, basic information science 1, basic information science 2, basic physics, basic mathematics.
<u>Specialized subjects</u>	Choice of 2 questions from the following 6 areas: Electrical engineering, communications engineering, electronic engineering, computer science 1, computer science 2, advanced physics.
<u>Basic and specialized subjects</u>	Choice of 3 questions from the following 6 areas: electromagnetics, electrical circuits, computer hardware, computer software, physics, basic mathematics.
Interview	Approx. 10-minute presentation about your university education or thesis (including the thesis now on writing), and research plans after entering this program, etc. Bring five copies of support materials with you.
